## AHMF 2020 NATIONAL HISTORIC MOTING FESTIVAL

Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> March to Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020

### **ENTRY FOR ALL CHILDREN UNDER 16 YEARS - FREE**

- To encourage family participation, there is NO CHARGE for children under the age of 16 years.
- The cost for the meal package for 16 & 17 year olds is only \$50 each.
- There are Special prizes and trophies for entrant drivers under 30 years of age.
- The Registration fee is waived for ALL past-recipients of Robert Shannon Foundation Grants
- This is a family-friendly event.

### **ALBURY-WODONGA VEHICLE GROUPS AND ROUTES**

Vehicles will be allocated groups according to era/speed of the vehicles - e.g. Veteran and Vintage will not be driving with 1980's vehicles; motorcycles will have their own route. There are also shorter and longer routes with "short-cut" options. **You don't have to stick to these groups**, though your morning tea/lunch packs will be issued on the day ordered for your allocated group.

This is your holiday and you can do as you wish. We are happy for you to have your own groups - e.g. SA touring group, CMC NSW touring group, Model T's, Plymouths, Morgans, etc.

There is a rolling-start through SS&A Club portico 8:30am to 9:30am daily. You need to attend if you have ordered lunch/morning tea packs. If not, you may prefer to depart from your motel / hotel / caravan park and avoid any congestion.

### **EVENT SUMMARY**

We have reacted from feedback from entrants, resulting in changes and improvements to the program. The main changes are Wednesday and Thursday programs have been swapped. We will continue to add and improve the program for you.

Due to lack of interest from many entrants, The Pizza oven evening and live band have been deleted. We have added pampering packages with Endota Spa Albury, an extra Festival Happy Hour evening Wednesday, Wine Appreciation, Beer Appreciation and Whiskey Appreciation on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday nights.

Reserved parking will be allocated for Morgan Country Car Club entrants so they can park safely upon arrival at the Display Day (after their swap).

### **ATTENDEE STATISTICS**

Entry of the older vehicles has waned a little with many owners of vintage vehicles entering their later model cars. Encourage friends and family members to bring out their older vehicles. We need more historic motorcycles also.

Statistics as at 31/5/2019 are:

- 20% of all vehicles entered are Veteran and Vintage; 43% are pre-1960; 57% are 1960 to 1995
- There is an average of 1.7 people per vehicle entered.
- The youngest driver entered (so far) is 21 years old, driving a 1923 vehicle.
- The oldest driver entered (so far) is driving a 1948 vehicle
- 2 nominations have been received for Youth Ambassadors, with another on the way.
- FVVCVC and FHMC SA have more entrants than any of the other councils, by a long way. We are pleased to have our first Tasmanian entrant and hope to increase this number after John & Robyn, Greg & I (and others) tour Tasmania early September.
