**President's Report** - Ray Ives

- Four Committee members met RMS personnel last December, at these meetings we are able to bring the concerns of our members to the people who are able to influence change at the RMS.

**Financial Reports** - Maxine Beale

Maxine explained that it was vital for member clubs to complete their Annual Affiliation and Census form each year to ensure that CHMC was kept updated with contact details for all clubs and their committees plus have a reasonably accurate number count on vehicles for the Registrar which helps any presentation to bodies such as the RMS.

- The affiliation fees due December 31, 2019 will be \$15 per club and \$1 per member.

- It was recommended to our clubs that approval not be given to use Historical Registered Vehicles for Point to Point operation i.e. fee for trip.
