

CHMC GENERAL MEETING, SATURDAY 28TH OCTOBER 2017, MUDGEE.

The complete Minutes have been sent to Affiliated Clubs but a few of the decisions and announcements included:

- **Kootingal Motor Club** (just north of Tamworth) admitted as an Affiliate.
- **Public Liability Insurance** Some Clubs have experienced significant insurance premium increases, particularly where Club examiners verify roadworthiness of vehicles. (Some Clubs have reported no increase, some a small decrease in premiums) Each club needs to ask its insurer what is included and what is covered, particularly if insurance costs have increased dramatically.
- **AHMF. 2020 National Tour** week-long rally has former AHMF president, Christine Stevens as Rally Director. There is support in Albury Wodonga as the Tour's final destination. The intention is to utilise the Old Hume Highway and for Clubs along the way to help as participants travel through the towns on the way to or from the Rally.
- **Robert Shannon Foundation** is currently a registered charity and is seeking tax deductibility for those making donations ie gift recipient classification. CHMC has had a few successful applicants. The Foundation is searching for extra funding to help our younger enthusiasts with their restorations.
- **CVS.** Clubs need to take responsibility/ownership for what is being submitted for registration of CVS vehicles. There is some flexibility, but CHMC has boundaries for acceptable vehicles that are published on the CHMC website. Photographs submitted with CVS applications should be informative and show all sides of the vehicle. CVS Applications – a steady flow. Vehicles need to be as near as possible to original. Engineering Certificates need to be dated within a reasonable time. Some of the issues presented have been motorbike converted to a cafe racer, suspensions over modified, Holden with disc brakes but not in that year, red motors for grey, Commodore with port modifications – many of these modifications are pushing the boundaries.
- There have been **numerous calls from clubs interested in CHMC** for access to CVS.
- **Conditional Registration** – HVS & CVS. CHMC has distributed to all affiliated clubs its current Guidelines on the HVS and CVS (as administered by CHMC) Schemes.
- **CHMC is a heritage-based Council** in accordance with directions from our Affiliated Clubs. CHMC Committee acts in accordance with these directions.
- **CHMC Annual Rallies.** The 2018 CHMC Rally at Narrabri will include options for a couple of runs. Friday night will be the AGM, and the Rally has the use of the RSL club. Entry cost for the Rally is \$120 to cover the cost of the outside marquee for the 3 days events if 150 – 200 vehicles are registered. The cost will decrease if there are fewer registrations as a smaller marquee would be hired. Accommodation is still available at Narrabri although the motels are experiencing heavier bookings.
- **2019 CHMC Rally.** Host clubs are Griffith Historic Car Club and MIA Veteran, Vintage and Classic Car Club. The Rally will be held in May and will incorporate National Heritage Motoring Day with the main run on Saturday.
- **Log Books.** RMS survey – CHMC input was acknowledged. Log book trial is extended for a further two years and perhaps a Log Book at the end of the trial, in the meantime RMS continues to issue a log book sheet. What the insurance companies consider when vehicles are on the log book trial may conflict with RMS statements. RMS description of “personal use” is wider than some insurance companies definition. Members need to continually monitor the terms of their Insurance company’s Product Disclosure Statement (PDS).
- **Misuse of the RMS Log Books** for historic and classic vehicles has been heard about but very difficult to enforce. Correct use of HVS and the Log Book is often dependent upon club culture. CHMC cannot take action against individuals, only Police, RMS and clubs can do this, and Police and RMS both appear to be occupied with more pressing matters.

- **CHMC Comfort Pack** information (this is the book with local Club contact details should you need help whilst travelling) will be placed on the web site and CHMC will discontinue the printed version.
