Eligible Vehicles	<p>Historic vehicles 30 years or older in as close to as practicable vehicle manufacturer's specifications. Safety features e.g. seatbelts, turn indicators, period accessories and options permissible.</p> <p>Includes cars, motorcycles, trucks, tractors and traction engines.</p> <p><i>LPG conversions</i> are allowed providing approved by the club and the relevant LPG certification is maintained</p>	<p>Modified vehicles 30 years of age or older as from the year of manufacture:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • up to 3.5 tonnes Gross Vehicle Mass • not being a plant vehicle or trailer, and • complying with the relevant NSW vehicle standard. <p><i>Non-modified historic vehicles can be registered under CVS but applicants should consider the comparative costs etc. with HVS</i></p>
Club membership requirement	Must be a financial and current member of a historic vehicle club recognised by the RMS	Must be a financial and current member of a club affiliated with an Approved Organisation (AO) (Currently AO's approved by RMS are the CHMC and ACMC)
Vehicle use	<p><i>Club Events or Club Day Book</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For events organised by or recorded in the Minutes of your club • For servicing within a short distance from the place of garaging • For the inspection of the vehicle. • Longer journeys must be notified to your club and the details recorded by the club in the official Minutes or 'Day Book'. <p><i>Logbook</i> one log book per vehicle per year.
